The combined concentration of ^{226}Ra + ^{228}Ra is often >5 pCi/L (the USEPA MCL value for Ra) in groundwater from the Cambrian-Ordovician aquifer. Water-quality characteristics that favor the mobility of radium include anoxic, Fe-reducing conditions and increased mineralization.
