It is cognate with other German and Baltic terms for the same idea, including Gothic *saiwala*, Old High German *sêula*, *sêla*, Old Saxon *sêola*, Old Low Franconian *sêla*, *sîla*, Old Norse *sála* and Lithuanian *siela*.
